THE COST FOR SERVICES IS BASED ON THE STATE SLIDING FEE SCALE. YOU MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING WITH YOU WHEN YOU ATTEND YOUR EVALUATION:

1. **If you are working, please bring proof of income.** You may provide a pay check stub, W-2 form, tax return, disability. **If you do not provide this information, we will have no choice but to bill you for the amount of \$253.00** which is the full cost for the evaluation only.
2. **If you have insurance, please bring proof of medical insurance or medical assistance.** Please bring your medical card if you have insurance. Please call ahead to inquire whether your insurance is accepted by the State for our services.
3. **If you are not working and do not have insurance, you must apply for PAC (Primary Adult Care) insurance to be seen.**
The following documents are necessary to complete the application, please bring:
1) A Birth Certificate, 2) A Photo ID, and 3), A letter from whoever is supporting you while you are out of work
4. **Please bring \$8.50 for payment on your urinalysis.** You will be required to provide a urinalysis at the time of your evaluation.
5. **You must allow at least 2 hours for the assessment,** although many evaluations do not take quite that long.
6. **All adolescents (children under 18 years of age), must be accompanied by an adult.** (Parent or legal guardian).
